

Parkour originates from the French term "le parcours" meaning "the course". Developed from military obstacle course training techniques, it focuses on getting from A to B as quickly and efficiently as possible using combinations of running, swinging, climbing, vaulting, jumping, rolling and quadrupedal movements.


