Dear Parents and Students of Year 5 and 6,

The West Leederville Super Choir auditions for 2020 will be held next week before school and during lunch time on Tuesday 11 of February, Wednesday 12th of February and Friday 14 of February. Once expression of interest is made via the permission slip below, a timetable of audition times will be displayed in the window of the music room on Monday 10 of February.

The super Choir will be a select group of Year 5 and 6 students who demonstrate a genuine interest in singing within a choir and improving their musical skills. The criteria for selection will be based on student ability to demonstrate rhythmic and aural competence that is needed to contribute to a fun and successful choir.

Audition preparation

✚ Please prepare **one minutes' worth of your favourite singing song (make sure it showcases your voice) to sing without music.**

✚ Be prepared to follow some **simple rhythmic and melodic patterns.**

Miss Samsa informs me that the Super Choir has become a popular extracurricular activity at West Leederville. With only a limited number of places available, it is essential that children only audition if they can make a yearly commitment to the weekly rehearsals (sometimes more than one a week before a performance) and full participation in school and out of school events.

The Super Choir rehearsal time will be every **Wednesday morning** from 8:00am-8:45am in the music room.
