Dear **Parents/Guardian,**

Web browser access is via www.connect.det.wa.edu.au. For mobile device weblink access instructions see below .

Students are all enrolled in a form class, as in Year 2 White, then in Specialist classes, as in Year 2 Art, Year 2 Music. Each student can only see the classes they are enrolled in.

In most cases, your child's username is their first name (fullstop) last name ie bill.brown with the password 123. For some students, that username has a number at the end. Please see the note from your classroom teacher to check this.

Students in BYO classes from Year 4 upwards may have had their password changed at school. The student will be able to advise you if this is the case.

Please check your child's access at home and let your child's teacher know by email, if you are unable to log in. We will rectify this as soon as we can.

iPhone Weblink Instructions (How to create a web page shortcut on your iPhone Home Screen)

1. Open Safari and navigate to the **web** page you want to **create** a shortcut icon for.
2. Tap on the Share button at the bottom center of the screen.
3. On the second row of options, tap on Add to Home Screen.
4. You will be prompted to enter a title for your shortcut. Done!

iPad Weblink Instructions (How to create a web page shortcut on your iPhone Home Screen)

1. Open the Safari browser and go to the **website** you want to save to the home screen.
2. Tap the Share icon.
3. Tap Add to Home Screen.
4. A window appears with the name of the site, the **URL**, and an icon.
5. Tap Add to complete the task. Done!

Android Weblink Instructions (How to create a web page shortcut on your iPhone Home Screen)

1. Launch Google Chrome browser app. Just tap on the Google Chrome icon on your home screen or app drawer.
2. Go to the website you want to save. Enter the website in the search/text bar and press "Enter."
3. Tap on the Menu button. ... (three dots)
4. Tap Add to Home Screen. Done!
