

Dear Parents/Guardians of Years 3 - 6 students,

I would like to extend an opportunity to your child to participate in the Australian Mathematics Competition, which will be held between Thursday 30 July and Thursday 6 August 2020. (actual competition date yet to be decided) The entry fee is \$6.50. This year, all students will participate in an online testing environment.

This is an internationally recognised competition that has been held annually since 1978. The competition aims to be accessible to all children; not just the mathematically talented. However, the 30 questions presented in the competition emphasise problem-solving and high-level thinking.

Through strong performance, participants can qualify to receive a Certificate of High Distinction, Distinction or Credit, or alternatively, a Certificate of Participation or a Proficiency Certificate. All students receive a detailed report showing how they performed on each problem, with wider statistical rankings.

If you would like your child to participate, please return the consent form to your child's teacher and provide the **\$6.50 entry fee** by **Friday 3 July 2020**.
