2026 Schedule

The West Leederville Primary School Board has endorsed this new schedule of Contributions, Charges and Fees for 2026. This is in accordance with the Department of Education's School Education Regulations, 2000 and School Education Act 1999. Financial support by parents plays a significant role in providing resources that extend our school's ability to add value to the learning experiences of students.

Please find attached a schedule that states all expenses you might incur in the 2026 academic year. All amounts that have been included are the maximum and will not exceed this amount. The Schedule is broken into four sections: voluntary contributions, voluntary approved requests, charges and other optional costs and personal items.

1. Voluntary Contributions

According to School Education Act 1999, schools request a contribution of up to \$60 per child from Kindergarten to Year 6. Though this contribution remains voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes a contribution. The money collected from contributions will supplement funds gained from other sources including State and Commonwealth Government. Your contribution extends the school's capacity to add value to your child's learning experiences.

1:1 iPad Program Year 4-6

A 1:1 iPad program commences in Year 4 at West Leederville Primary School. This allows students to use ICT effectively and to become digital citizens. The approximate cost of the iPad will be between \$600-\$700. Participation in this program is voluntary, however strongly encouraged.

3. Charges and Other Optional Costs

Some of these activities will apply to all students, whilst others, such as IMSS, PEAC and Interschool events, only apply to selected students. Students will only incur costs if they are involved in the activity. The charges represent a maximum for the scheduled activities and parents will be advised of the actual charges when payment is due.

Personal Use Items

The *Student Personal Item* list covers the items students require to fully participate in the learning activities. The list of items will vary by year level.
